**A RESOLUTION OF THE CECIL TOWNSHIP  
MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A TAPPING  
FEE REFUND PROGRAM FOR CUSTOMERS IN  
THE MILLERS RUN WATERSHED**

**WHEREAS**, the Cecil Township Municipal Authority (the “Authority”) undertook to construct the Millers Run Sanitary Sewer Project beginning in 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority utilized several sources of funding for the project including its Guaranteed Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series of 2004 and Series of 2006, along with a grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority applied for and was awarded a grant in the amount of Five Million (\$5,000,000.00) Dollars from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania’s Commonwealth Finance Authority through its H2O program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority, pursuant to the requirements of Act 57 of 2003, was required to recalculate the applicable tapping fees for the Millers Run sewershed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority, based on the receipt of the aforementioned grant is able to fund its rate stabilization fund to the extent that general funds will be available to provide

refunds to customers who have previously paid tapping fees for their use of the Millers Run system.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:**

1. With respect to residential, commercial, or industrial structures that have paid the applicable tapping fee on or before May 31, 2010, the Authority will refund fifty (50%) percent of the amount previously paid for tapping fees on an equivalent dwelling unit basis (the “Refund Program”). The special purpose component of the tapping fee applicable to commercial and/or industrial properties will be refunded as described below in paragraph 4.
2. The Refund Program will be implemented beginning on or after June 6, 2010.
3. Eligibility for participation in the Refund Program will be determined at the sole discretion of the Board of the Authority.
4. The special purpose component of the tapping fee for commercial/industrial customers will be reduced to Four Thousand Three Hundred (\$4,300.00) Dollars per pound of BOD exceeding the calculated equivalent domestic loading, thus resulting in a Four Hundred Fifty-Three (\$453.00) Dollar per pound of BOD refund to customers who paid this component of the tapping fee.
