RESOLUTION NO.: 2010-3**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CECIL TOWNSHIP
MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING AND
AMENDING TAPPING FEES PURSUANT TO ACT 57 OF 2003**

WHEREAS, the Cecil Township Municipal Authority (the “Authority”) previously enacted its Resolution 2008-3 regarding the charging of tapping fees pursuant to Act 57 of 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is the recipient of a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania’s H2O Program for the Millers Run Project; and

WHEREAS, the receipt of the grant requires the Authority to recalculate the applicable fees for connection to the system; and

WHEREAS, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A is an itemization of all calculations showing the maximum fees allowable for each part of the tapping fee and for each sub-district within the Millers Run sewershed along with the manner in which the fees have been determined; and

WHEREAS, the Authority upon the proper motion and second has adopted its tapping fees at its May 18, 2010 meeting pursuant to Act 57 of 2003, and same will be effective as of June 1, 2010.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS
FOLLOWS:**

1. The tapping fee for residential customers serviced by sewers in the Millers Run sewershed not utilizing the Casciola or Windsor Woods Sewer collection systems is Six Thousand Four Hundred Eighty (\$6,480.00) Dollars per equivalent dwelling unit (“EDU”).

2. The tapping fee for residential customers serviced by sewers in the Millers Run sewershed and utilizing the Casciola and Windsor Woods collection systems is Three Thousand Six Hundred (\$3,600.00) Dollars per EDU, unless as determined by prior agreement between the Authority and any developer.

3. The tapping fee for commercial/industrial customers utilizing the Casciola and/or Windsor Woods collection systems is Three Thousand Six Hundred (\$3,600.00) Dollars per EDU with a special purpose fee of Four Thousand Three Hundred (\$4,300.00) Dollars per pound of excess BOD, unless as determined by prior agreement between the Authority and any developer.

4. The tapping fee for commercial/industrial customers located within the Millers Run sewershed is Six Thousand Four Hundred Eighty (\$6,480.00) Dollars per EDU with a special purpose fee of Four Thousand Three Hundred (\$4,300.00) Dollars per pound of excess BOD.

5. The above-stated fees are in effect on June 1, 2010.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT ALL OTHER RESOLUTIONS
INCONSISTENT HERewith ARE DEEMED RESCINDED.**
